

It could be Time for a...



The new tax law could affect how much your employer should withhold from your paycheck. You should do a paycheck checkup! Visiting the IRS's [Withholding Calculator](#) now will help prevent you having too little or too much withheld from your paycheck. The calculator helps determine the right amount of withholding. If necessary, you can also complete a new [W-4 form](#).

You should check if you:

- Are a two-income family.
- Have two or more jobs at the same time or only work part of the year.
- Claim credits like the child tax credit.
- Have dependents age 17 or older.
- Itemized deductions in 2017.
- Have high income or a complex tax return.
- Have a large tax refund or tax bill for 2017.
